

## Wedding Photography FAQ's

- Why do you show all the weddings you do on your website and not just your best pictures?
  - o This is simple; you deserve to see all that we are and all that we do. If we show you 20 pictures from 20 different weddings, you still only see 20 great pictures. We typically take over 2,000 pictures per wedding. So why shouldn't you be allowed to see all 2,000? You won't only get 1 good picture from your wedding.
- What is your style?
  - o Our style is really mixed. We do traditional posed formals and also candid formals, however we never want to be a distraction at your wedding. We do everything we can to capture your moments without being a part of them. Most would consider this photojournalism. We land somewhere in between. Ashley and I each have our own style as well.
- How long do you need for formal photos?
  - o We would like to have an hour and a half for formal photos. If you are seeing each other before the wedding, we would like to start 2 hours before the wedding start time. If you are not seeing each other before the wedding, then we would like to start an hour and half before the wedding.
- Can others take pictures during formals?
  - o We love that other people want to take pictures, and we encourage it. Each moment can be captured from an infinite number of angles. While we make every effort to cover everything, we could always use a dozen assistants or so....also known as aunts and uncles. We only ask that during formals we are allowed to get our shot, and then we will step back and allow everyone else to take theirs.
- Where do you take pictures from during the ceremony?
  - o Because we always have two photographers, we are able to take pictures from several angles. One photographer will be near the front, but not past the first row of pews. The second photographer will be near the back or on a balcony. Our goal is to not be a distraction at your wedding. Your day is all about you. If we create a distraction then you lose some luster from your moment. We don't want your guest to be talking about the photographer at the reception.....at least not in a bad way.
- Do you take pictures outside?
  - o Of course...and preferably. Formals and indoor pictures are great and have their place. But if we can get outside and take some random and fun shots, those always tend to turn out best. The more fun that you have, the more fun we will have and that will really come through in the photos.
- Will the person I meet be the photographer at my wedding?
  - o In short, yes. Most wedding meetings are conducted by Ashley and I; some times she will conduct meetings by herself. We are Nuzum Photo. However, from time to time, Ashley is unable to make some weddings so we have a third photographer that works with me at those weddings who is also a part of Nuzum Photo.
- What kind of deposit is due?
  - o Your deposit is due when you sign your contract with us. It is typically half of the total package amount. However, we are very flexible and do allow for some payments. So your deposit may be ¼ of your cost if you want to make 4 payments.
- When is the final payment due?
  - o Final payment is due when you pick up your proofs from us after the wedding. No payment is due on your wedding day. What a hassle!
- Will you run (ruin) my wedding day?
  - o Absolutely not. We work with you ahead of time and work out a photography schedule that is perfect for you. We are non-intrusive and only there to capture the moments that make up your day.
- Can I see an example of an entire wedding day?
  - o Of course. In our online proofing gallery we maintain all the weddings we photograph. Please stop in and take a look through any wedding. It is a great thing, to see the types of photos we take from the time we arrive until the time we depart.
- How long will my digital proofs be online?
  - o At least one year. As of right now we are not removing any prior weddings. However, as storage space shrinks we may have to reconsider this policy. It will always be at least one year.
